Wiki inside project

[[Guide#User manual Manual]]	same as above and link text is ,Manual'

Wiki outside project

[[some-project:]]	link to main wiki page of project ,Some Project' (project identifier ,some-project')
[[some-project:SEO]]	link to wiki page ,SEO' of project ,Some Project' (font color is red if wiki page does not exist)

Link to ressources

Note: use double quotes (") if title contains spaces.

Links to documents

document#3	link to document with id 3
document:Manual	link to document with title ,Manual'
some-project:document:"User guide"	link to document with title ,User guide' inside project ,some-project'

Links to versions

version#39	link to version with id 39
version:1.0.3	link to version with title ,1.0.3'
some-project:version:"Version 4.0"	link to version with title ,Version 4.0' inside project ,some-project'

Link to attachments

Note: only attachments of the current object (i.e. ticket, wiki page etc.) can be referenced.

attachment: file.txt	link to attachment ,file.txt' of current object

Formatting modifiers

(adds 1em of padding to the left for each ,(, character
)	adds 1em of padding to the right for each ,)' character
<	aligns to the left (floats to left for tables if combined with the ,)' modifier)
>	aligns to the right (floats to right for tables if combined with the ,(, modifier)
=	aligns to center (sets left, right margins to ,auto' for tables).
<>	justifies text
{style rule}	a CSS style rule
